And of course if you live in Auckland but for any reason need help to get to the hospital in Grafton for your appointments, we're here for you too.

This service is completely free, all you need to do is let Unicorn Foundation NZ know the dates of your PRRT and we'll tailor a plan to get you safely to and from your PRRT treatment at ADHB.
